

Zeitz MOCAA would like to issue this statement:

In light of recent developments regarding the impact of COVID-19, Zeitz MOCAA will be temporarily closed from today, 17 March until 06 April 2020.

The health of our staff, guests, partners, and artists is a priority and we are taking measures to reduce the spread of the virus according to the guidelines of the World Health Organisation and the South African Government.

We heed the call by Cyril Ramaphosa, the South African president, and his recent address to the nation, that "this situation calls for an extraordinary response" and the government's plan of action will be followed.

We are currently evaluating the impact of these measures on our future exhibitions and programming and are working with artists and stakeholders to evaluate this changing environment.

We are continuously monitoring this situation and further updates will follow as soon as possible.

General admission tickets already booked for this period will either be fully refunded or accepted for entry when the museum re-opens.
